Fees must accompany entries.

Canadian Exhibitors **MUST** make all checks and/or money orders payable in U.S. funds.

ENTRY FORM REQUIREMENTS

Telephone, telegraph and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent, or if the dog is entered in a class in which it is not eligible to compete. THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. The Secretary will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Bitches that come into season after the closing date for entries may have the entry fee refunded less \$4.00 per class upon written request of the owner or handler before the start of judging of the Trial on the day of the Trial the dog was entered. **All Mail in Entries cancelled before closing will be returned and will incur a \$4 entry processing fee. All Entries that were taken ONLINE and cancelled before closing will be returned minus the credit card company's processing fee and the \$4 entry processing fee.**

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.

TRANSFERS

TRANSFERS will be allowed at these Obedience Trials.

- Transfers prior to the trial must be received by 8:00 pm PDT on Monday, September 21, 2026.
- Transfers between shows must be turned in within 1/2 hour of the trial ending.

- **Phone transfers** will not be accepted.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern these Shows and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium list.

Club May Cancel Events due to extreme weather conditions.

We are fortunate to have a wonderful facility for our Obedience Trials.

The Cash's Arena is on private property and we MUST respect the owners and their property.

SMOKING: No smoking allowed anywhere on the Cash's property.

There is NO RV parking available.

Participants must be responsible for their personal hygiene and health.

If you are not feeling well, we hope you plan to stay home.

JUDGING: Dogs may arrive any time prior to their time of judging, and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging. The Club will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class; it is not the responsibility of the ring steward to locate any dog, its owner or its agent when the dog's presence is needed in the judging ring. Judges will NOT wait for any dog holding up a class.

RING SIZE: The Obedience ring will be 40' x 50'.

RUN ORDER: Trial will start with tallest and continue in descending order.

CRATING: There will be room to crate inside the arena. Sherwood Dog Training Club is not responsible for any crates or equipment left overnight. **No "tents" or x-pens will be allowed.** Dogs may not be left overnight in the building.

Important notice for DOGS IN UNVENTILATED VEHICLES:

All persons attending this dog event hereby waive any claim for damages against Sherwood Dog Training Club or its members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

CHILDREN: It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the trial. Parents are expected and will supervise their children at all times.

LIABILITY: Sherwood Dog Training Club will take all possible measures to ensure the welfare of dogs and exhibitors alike, but does not assume responsibility nor liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, or spectators at these events. In the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from a life-threatening condition, the owner/handler/exhibitor of that dog and owner of the vehicle waive all claims for damages against the Sherwood Dog Training Club.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

CLEAN UP INSIDE AND OUTSIDE THE RINGS: The rings are the responsibility of the exhibitors. Your cooperation in exercising your dog before entering the ring will be appreciated. Exhibitors are expected to keep the area around their crates and vehicles clean, including cleanup in any and all parking areas.

EXHIBITOR RESPONSIBILITY: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable disease, and have appropriate vaccinations.

LOSS OR DAMAGE: The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this Trial. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor.

NOTICE TO NOVICE A OR NOVICE B EXHIBITORS: Sherwood Dog Training Club loves and encourages new people to Obedience. The club is offering for you to have a specific person, a mentor so to speak, that would be available if you have questions and to make your Novice time at a Trial a positive experience. CJ Johnson will be available before and on the day of trial to help if you need information about crating, how to use the warm up ring, how to check in at the trial and any other concerns.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

Directions to the Cash's Arena: 17720 SW Elsner Rd, Sherwood, OR 97140

From I-5 Exit 289, travel west on Tualatin-Sherwood Road all the way to 99W, 4.7 miles. Cross 99W, Tualatin/Sherwood Road becomes Roy Rogers. Stay on Roy Rogers for 2 miles, Turn right on Elsner.

(If you got to Al's Garden Center you went too far.)

The Cash's driveway is on the right a little more than a ½ mile. Please drive slowly as their driveway is one way. Parking is available in the front on asphalt. If that is full, park to the side or behind the arena.

If you went too far on Roy Rogers, turn right on Beef Bend, then right on Elsner, then the Cash's drive way will be on the left in about a mile.



AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us). I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN THIS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. Instructions1.(Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in., but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).2.The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rules refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
