ELIGIBILITY: Untitled dog's entries test entries must be accompanied with
an original, signed certification by an approved or provisional AKC Tracking
Judge or an Evaluator (any person who has titled a TDX or VST dog within
the past ten (10) years.) The certification must be dated within 24 months of
the event. Open to Purebred and All-American Dogs listed in the AKC Canine
Partners Program.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season may participate in this test with prior
notice to the Test Secretary and provided that all provisions of Chapter 2, Section 8
of the AKC Tracking Regulations are complied with.

DRAWING: A random draw for entries and alternate list will be held on
Thursday, November 13, 2026, at 6:00 pm PST

ALTERNATE LIST: An alternate list shall be maintained and will consist of entries received by
the closing date, but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately
follow the drawing for the limited entries.

NOTIFICATION: The results of the draw will be sent as soon as possible following the draw. Should such notification not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Test Secretary.

SDTC REFUND POLICY: The entry fee shall be refunded within seven (7) days after the test in the following cases: 1) The entrant notifies the Test Secretary prior to the Test that they are withdrawing from the test, and an alternate runs the track, or 2) For an entrant or alternate that is not given an opportunity to run a track.

DRAWING FOR RUNNING ORDER: All dogs and handlers must be at the Test Headquarters, Jernstedt Rd Fields 8900 NE Jernstedt Rd, Carlton, OR 97111 by 9:00 a.m. Sunday, November 22, 2026, at which time there will be a drawing to determine running order. Entrants not present at the time of the drawing will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

JUDGING: Judging will begin as soon as the tracks have aged sufficiently.

AWARDS: An award will be offered for each dog passing the test.

HEALTH AND SAFETY: The health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, judges, and spectators is of paramount importance. The test may be cancelled or stopped before completion in the case of extreme weather conditions such as, but not limited to, lightning, extreme heat, hurricanes, floods, or earthquakes, for the well-being of people and dogs. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

DIRECTIONS:

To Jernstedt Rd Fields 8900 NE Jernstedt Rd, Carlton, OR 97111

Maps will be at Headquarters near the test fields.

From Portland: Use US26 towards Beaverton. Take exit 57 from US-26 W (North Plains) Turn Left over freeway to first signal light.

Take NW Zion Church Rd, NW Cornelius Schefflin Rd and NW Martin Rd to OR-47 S/Quince St in Forest Grove

Turn left onto OR-47 S/Quince St

Continue to follow OR-47 S for 19 miles

Turn left onto State Hwy 47 S/Main St (signs for McMinnville)
for 1.5 miles

Turn right onto NE Jernsted.

From Tigard and locations south of Portland:

Follow 99W from Tigard through Sherwood and Newberg. Turn right on Main St and follow OR240 (Yamhill-Newberg Hwy). Continue to follow OR-240 W 5.6 mi. Turn left onto NE Kuehne Rd 1.8 mi Continue onto NE Hendricks. Turn Left onto NE Mineral Springs Rd. Turn right onto NE Jernstedt Rd.

PRACTICING: Practicing on the test sites is not allowed as the Test is on private property.

Dogs **MUST** be kept on leash at **ALL** times.

Your cooperation in adhering to the regulations will be greatly appreciated.

Handlers are expected to clean up after their dogs immediately.

Ticks are present in the area.

NOTE: Headquarters may not be on the test grounds. Please check the Judging Program for exact location for Headquarters.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. Instructions 1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Gocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in., but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard). 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division. 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
